Student Union of University of Oulu (OYY)

- A community of around 12 000 members, and a lobbyingand service organization
- Supervises the interests of students in the university and in the city of Oulu
- Offers guidance and assistance in studying and student life related matters
- Organizes free-time activities
- Supports, aids and trains student organizations operating within the Oulu academic community
- Supports and trains student representatives of the university administration







University of Oulu Graduate School (UniOGS)

- Coordinates doctoral training in the University of Oulu since 2011
- Main task to provide high quality doctoral education at the University of Oulu
- Supervised by the Vice Rector of Education and led by the UniOGS coordinator
- Consists of a management group and four field-specific doctoral training committees with student representation in each
 - Health and Biosciences
 - Human Sciences
 - Technology and Natural Sciences
 - Information Technology and Electrical Engineering
- 22 degree progams
- Approximately 1300 students, and 170 graduates in 2022







Doctoral Researchers' Section (DRS)




- Established 2013 as a community for doctoral researchers
- Supported and funded by OYY, although the Section is mostly run on a voluntary basis by doctoral researchers themselves
- Does advocacy and lobbying work within UniOGS, arranges events and trainings for doctoral researchers
- Offers an interdisciplinary platform for discussion of timely matters for doctoral student representatives and other doctoral researchers
- Collaborates with UniOGS for the development of doctoral training in Oulu university







Track Record:



- Preparing a survey to doctoral researchers concerning the quality of doctoral training in UniOGS + analyzing and disseminating the results
- Lobbying for changing the official title of PhD Students to Doctoral researchers
- Lobbying for 10 % work contracts to all doctoral researchers with a working grant
- Getting staff e-mails for all doctoral researchers regardless of employment status







Promoting Communality in the UniOGS:



- Meetings (approximately once in a month), open for all doctoral researchers
- Teams-channel, and a Facebook group open for all doctoral researchers
- Events: Picnics, networking, pre-Christmas Party
- Communicating activities and encouraging people to join via Social Media (esp. Instagram)
- Bilinguality (FIN/ENG)





Challenges:

- A diverse community is also a dispersed community
- Most doctoral researchers are already involved in a community related to i.e., their own research unit or study field
- Many are unaware of what the DRS is and what it does
- The activities might not be conceived as relevant to oneself
- DRS is often only approached due to some specific need, i.e., a problem to be solved
- Encouraging Finnish doctoral researchers to join as well









Future Points of Development:

- Developing the meetings and longer-term actions (i.e., via renewed rules and action plan)
- Working to have more doctoral researchers involved via active promotion of activities and consistent encouragement
- Finding people to commit to activities (i.e., chairmanship and student representative positions)
